**The Visitor** is a 2008 American drama film written and directed by Thomas McCarthy, starring Richard Jenkins, Haaz Sleiman and Danai Gurira

### **Storyline**

Widower and lonely Professor Walter Vale has a boring life. He teaches only one class at the local college and is trying to learn how to play the piano. He attends a conference about Global Policy and Development at New York University. When he arrives at his apartment in New York, he finds Tarek Khalil, a Syrian musician, and Zainab, a Senegalese street vendor living there. He sympathizes with the situation of the illegal immigrants and ends up inviting the couple to stay with him.



### **Parental Guidance**

This film is rated 15 mainly for the bad language sometimes used and is suitable for viewing from ages 15 and over.

### **Internet Movie Database:**

A college professor travels to New York City to attend a conference and finds a young couple living in his apartment. His life changes when he is forced to face issues relating to identity, immigration, and cross-cultural communication in post-9/11 New York City.
